



AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

Your affiant is a Pennsylvania State Trooper currently assigned to Troop G Rockview as a Criminal Investigator and has been employed as a State Trooper for nearly 12 years.

1.) On 11/21/16 at approximately 1600 hours the victims' father arrived at PSP Rockview advising his [redacted] year old [redacted] victim #1 who was [redacted] at the time, had received text messages from a 41 year old male, Jeffrey SANDUSKY, asking [redacted] of [redacted] and send them to him. The victims' father advised that the text messages in question were sent to victim #1's cell phone and were dated Tuesday March 1st 2016 and Wednesday March 2nd 2016. Victim #1 had saved the text messages from Jeffrey SANDUSKY and had sent them to him (victims' father) via screen shots/pictures on 11/20/16 after victim #1 had told [redacted] mother who then told SANDUSKY that he had to leave the residence as he had been living there for approximately 5 years. The victims' father then proceeded to show the text messages to me and then emailed them to me where they were printed off.

2.) While reviewing the text messages from Jeffrey SANDUSKY to victim #1 he asks [redacted] and that it's not weird because he studied medicine. Jeffrey SANDUSKY advises victim #1 that nobody needs to know and that [redacted] has his word. Jeffrey SANDUSKY then advises victim #1 to not show these texts to anyone. Jeffrey SANDUSKY then asks victim #1 again to send him [redacted] and advises that it's not for him and that he has already seen [redacted] Jeffrey SANDUSKY then again asks for [redacted] when victim #1 advises [redacted] is going to bed and to stop asking [redacted]

3.) Jeffrey SANDUSKY then asks [redacted] in the morning when [redacted] is dressing for school and advises [redacted] to erase all the texts and that none of this "shit" gets mentioned to anyone or seen by anyone. Jeffrey SANDUSKY asks victim #1 to take a [redacted] while [redacted] etc. Jeffrey then asks for a picture of victim #1 in [redacted] Victim #1 advises [redacted] does not want to and then Jeffrey advises [redacted] that they need to talk to get things straightened out. Victim #1 responds by stating; "no we don't need to talk and we aren't going to. You did what you did and I'm not going to give you a chance to try and justify it. You literally tried to guilt me into doing it and you even told me specifically what I "needed" to do. You know who does that? Rapists and Abusers, not [redacted] who care about their [redacted] I don't know how many times I need to tell you no and to stop before you get it."



AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE CONTINUATION

4.) After speaking with the victims' father, Tpr. WAKEFIELD and I then went to the residence of the victim and the victims' mother. Contact was made with the victims' mother who was explained the reason for the visit and the investigation into text messages received by her [REDACTED] victim #1, from Jeffrey SANDUSKY. The victims' mother advised that she and Jeffrey SANDUSKY have dated for approximately 6 years and he has resided with her and her children for approximately 5 years. The victims' mother asked Jeffrey SANDUSKY to leave yesterday evening when she was advised by her [REDACTED] that Jeffrey SANDUSKY had sent text messages to her [REDACTED] year old [REDACTED] at the time asking for [REDACTED]. The victims' mother gave permission for Tpr. WAKEFIELD and I to take her [REDACTED] cell phone to complete a cell phone extraction. After the cell phone extraction was completed the content was reviewed and the text messages from 03/01/16 and 03/02/16 were printed off between victim #1 and Jeffrey SANDUSKY.

5.) On Saturday 12/10/16 at approximately 1655 hours I interviewed the victims' mother at PSP Rockview in regards to this incident. The victims' mother was presented with the cell phone messages between Jeffrey SANDUSKY and her [REDACTED] victim #1, on 03/01/16 and 03/02/16 of this year. While reading through the text messages I observed the victims' mother start to become emotional. The victims' mother advised that Jeffrey SANDUSKY had advised her that he was trying to help her [REDACTED] by getting [REDACTED] off the internet and needed [REDACTED] to do it and to "role play". The victims' mother advised that the texts are "fucked up". The victims' mother went on to advise that there were not any pictures of her [REDACTED] year old [REDACTED] on the internet and when she was advised by her [REDACTED] of the inappropriate texts she confronted him and asked him to leave. Jeffrey SANDUSKY advised her that he was sorry and didn't remember what he had said and then opened up and advised he knows it was wrong and inappropriate.

6.) After speaking with the victims' mother I interviewed her [REDACTED] victim #1, at PSP Rockview at approximately 1750 hours on 12/10/16. Victim #1 advised that [REDACTED] has constantly felt that Jeffrey SANDUSKY has looked at [REDACTED] inappropriately and stares at [REDACTED] but doesn't think Jeffrey has seen [REDACTED]. Recently, while [REDACTED] was in the shower, [REDACTED] could hear Jeffrey SANDUSKY walking down the hallway and hears the footsteps stop as if someone is looking into the bathroom. Victim #1 advised that there is a crack near the door and you can see into the bathroom if you are trying to look into it. Victim #1 also related that [REDACTED] now gets a shower while Jeffrey SANDUSKY is at work or not at the residence because [REDACTED] does not feel safe with him there.

7.) Victim #1 advised that in regards to the text messages [redacted] received from Jeffrey SANDUSKY [redacted] has only received texts like this once. The texts were read and victim #1 advised that all those texts were accurate and [redacted] received them from Jeffrey SANDUSKY on 03/01/16 and 03/02/16 and recently sent them to [redacted] father. The night of these texts [redacted] advised [redacted] was in [redacted] bedroom and that Jeffrey was on the couch and their mother was sleeping. Jeffrey SANDUSKY had advised [redacted] that he knew [redacted] was doing sexual stuff and that there were [redacted] on the internet. Victim #1 advised [redacted] knew his talk was "bullshit". Victim #1 advised that the texts that had been sent by Jeffrey SANDUSKY to [redacted] were disrespectful, wrong and that he shouldn't be asking stuff like that. Victim #1 advised that the texts made [redacted] feel uncomfortable and that he kept pressuring me and asked me multiple times to not show the texts to anyone and to erase them. Victim #1 then advised that [redacted] never told [redacted] mother initially because he, Jeffrey SANDUSKY, makes my mother happy, however did tell [redacted] victim #2, the next day. Victim #1 also advised that Jeffrey SANDUSKY has made sexual comments before to [redacted] and stated "he is always looking at me in weird ways, starring me up and down".

8.) Victim #1 went on to advise that if [redacted] were in the house by [redacted] with Jeffrey SANDUSKY [redacted] feels he would try and do something to [redacted] and that [redacted] does not feel safe with him at the house. Victim #1 went on to advise [redacted] victim #2, confronted Jeffrey the next day after [redacted] had told [redacted] what Jeffrey had done to [redacted] Victim #2 then advised [redacted] victim #1, that he had done the same type of thing several years back to [redacted] when he asked [redacted] Victim #1 advised that [redacted] was told by Jeffrey that he would never do this again and promised not to do anything like this to [redacted]

9.) On Sunday 12/11/16 at approximately 0900 hours, victim #2, now [redacted] years of age, arrived at PSP Rockview and was interviewed in regards to this incident. Victim #2 advised that [redacted] had told [redacted] the following morning on 03/02/16 about texts that Jeffrey had sent [redacted] asking [redacted] and send them to him. Victim #2 advised that [redacted] was very upset that Jeffrey had done this and that [redacted] asked Jeffrey to go for a drive with him. During the drive victim #2 advised "I tore into him" and yelled at him advising him [redacted] knew about the texts [redacted] had received from him. Jeffrey advised [redacted] that it's not what you think and that he knows a guy that could remove [redacted] from the internet. Victim #2 advised [redacted] knew he was lying and he couldn't provide me with any name when I asked him and told Jeffrey that this shouldn't be happening. Jeffrey went on to advise [redacted] "I can't even say anything except I'm sorry". Victim #2 advised [redacted] didn't tell their mother because they didn't want to put that on their mothers' plate and cause her additional stress.
